

Here's a state-by-state rundown of minimum wage rates for 2020. Bear in mind that, when a state has no minimum wage or a minimum wage lower than the federal rate, employees covered by the federal Fair Labor Standards Act must be paid the federal minimum wage of \$7.25 per hour for 2020.

*Note:* States where the minimum wage has increased since the beginning of 2019 are shown in bold face.
